2nd October	She Walks in Beauty & JE	Examine the similarities between She Walks in Beauty and one other poem in the Love Through the Ages pre 1900 Anthology and Jane Eyre during her time at Thornfield.
9th October	Othello Act 1 Sc 3 line 50 – 75	How does Shakespeare's character Brabantio try to explain why his daughter has married Othello?
16th October	To His Coy Mistress & JE	How do the writers convey their ideas about the intensity of love and relationships in Jane Eyre, To His Coy Mistress and one other poem in the Love Through the Ages pre 1900 Anthology?
30th October	Othello Act 1 Sc 3 line 75 - 120	How does Shakespeare introduce Othello to the audience through his explanation of his marriage Desdemona.

13th November	Othello Act 1 Sc 3 line 128 - 180	How does Shakespeare convey the romance between Desdemona and Othello?
20th November	Sonnet 116 & JE	Sonnet 116 seems to present the idea of true love overcoming all impediments. Link this and one other poem in the Love Through the Ages pre 1900 Anthology to Rochester's and St John's feelings for Jane in the novel.
27th November	Othello Act 1 Sc 3 - soliloquy Act 2 Sc 1	How does Shakespeare foreshadow what is to happen through the reference to 'storms' such as line 245 'storm of fortunes' ?
4th December	A Song (Absent from thee) & JE	Look at the sections in the novel where Jane leaves Thornfield, Lowood and Gateshead. Consider the sense of loss felt here and link it to A Song (Absent from thee) and one other poem in the Love Through the Ages pre 1900 Anthology
11th December	Othello Act 2 Sc 1 line 1 59	How does Shakespeare use language to convey the attitudes to Othello? Are they praising or criticising Othello?
