Dear Parents/Guardians

Our student led charity council have requested permission for a non-uniform day on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2018 which Mrs Jenner has granted.

The council will be supporting Teens Unite with some of the money they raise. This is a teenage cancer charity. They will also be using some of the money raised to purchase lunch time activity equipment for September. These have been chosen by the Student Charity Committee.

Obviously if your son/daughter would prefer, they can choose to wear their normal school uniform. A small donation of £2 to wear their own clothes and raise money for charity, will be collected by our Sixth Form charity council on the school gates and in registration in the morning on Friday. Naturally if any student wanted to make a bigger donation, this will be welcomed by the charity.

Charity days at Roding Valley are always fun days, with students entering into the spirit of giving and good will. We would however ask you to be mindful of the choice of outfit for the day. We will not allow students to wear clothes, hats or facial masks that cover their faces, unless this is in keeping with their normal cultural dress code. We will also not allow students to wear clothes that reveal large amounts of their bodies, particularly chest and shoulder areas. Skirts and shorts should also be worn at an appropriate length. We would also expect students to make sound footwear choices – high heels or flimsy shoes in a school environment can be dangerous. If a student is dressed inappropriately, we may well be calling you to collect them.

Students will be released from classes from 12.20pm on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2018 for the Summer break. Please discourage your son/daughter from congregating in large groups and please refer to my previous letter raising some concerns about the safety of the local fields.
